

We have been honored and privileged to have an active duty member, Major Jason Mayne, serve on the board as our 1st Vice President this year. It was a joy to have the benefit of his experience and astute judgment at our monthly meetings. We are proud to announce that he was selected for promotion to Lieutenant Colonel, but of course this resulted in his transfer. He has since reported to Joint Interagency Task Force South in Key West, Florida. He was Commander of the 92nd

Communications Squadron at Fairchild. At his change of command ceremony on 11 July he was awarded the Meritorious Service Medal by his immediate superior, Col David Stookey, USAF. He also received the Washington Air National Guard medal from MAJ Jason Kesler, 141st CF/CC.

Major Mayne's primary accomplishments included a "Be Smart, Restart" security program, replacement of the base firewall and proxy suite, cyber security, nuclear command/control/communications systems, and his unit being named as a benchmark for the base software licensing manager program. Proposed Amendments to Chapter Bylaws

Because of time constraints, we didn't vote on amendments to the chapter bylaws at the June social, so we'll do it at the 18 September one. These are the amendments which have been approved by the Board of Directors.

Reasons for these amendments are as follows:

- Decomposition of the state of t
- To allow (but not require) the Widows and Wives Club to nominate the Surviving Spouse board member.
- To allow a Surviving Spouse who is already a board member to represent the Surviving Spouses on the board, and to specify that no person may exercise multiple votes.
- 2 To allow a Director to simultaneously serve as Secretary and/or Treasurer.

Proposed amendments to the chapter bylaws which will be voted on at the September social (changes are in *italics*):

- 1. Change the term "Auxiliary" to "Surviving Spouses" throughout (in six locations) as follows:
 - a. Change Article 3, Para. 2 to read as follows: *Surviving Spouse Members*. Widows and widowers of deceased officers, who would, if living, be eligible for membership. Chapter *Surviving Spouse* members will be entitled to all the rights and privileges of regular members.
 - b. Change Article 4, Para. 1 to read as follows: 1. The Board of Directors consists of the elected officers, the immediate past president, the *Surviving Spouse* Liaison, and at least five (5) and not more than six (6) elective Directors.
 - c. Change Article 5, Para. 2 to read as follows: Officers and the *Surviving Spouse* Liaison shall be elected by the voting membership, and shall hold office for one year, unless sooner removed or otherwise disqualified. The *Surviving Spouse* Liaison shall be a *Surviving Spouse* member of the chapter in good standing.
- 2. Modify Article 5 paragraph 1 to read as follows: "Officers of the organization shall consist of a President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. A Director may also serve as Secretary and/or Treasurer until a suitable replacement for one or both positions is found. A Board member who is a Surviving Spouse may also serve as the Surviving Spouses Liaison. No person may exercise multiple votes.
- 3. Add the following sentence to Article 5 paragraph 2: The "Widows & Wives Club may nominate (not elect) the Surviving Spouse board member.
